

1 Pyle said these are outpatient claims for inmates and pursuant to the written indigent agreement we
2 have with the hospital, we pay 77% of outpatient and the hospital agrees to write off the rest. Prior to
3 the Safety Net Care Pool, Pyle said these are the funds that were applied against the Sole Community
4 Provider Program and we never issued a check to PRMC. He said now we are sending over \$800,000 to
5 the State and we have this additional cost of \$22,124.41. He requested this is tabled and said he has
6 something he wants to offer the hospital administrator and see if they can reach an agreement and
7 bring back for consideration to address the expense for the County. **Motion to table Item 4.** Bostwick
8 said this is a point of double pay. He said we send the State the money and then the hospital wants
9 theirs too.


