A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MANAGER
TO APPROVE CERTAIN LINE ITEM TRANSFERS

WHEREAS, Curry County annually, prepares and establishes a budget for its fiscal year, which is submitted to and approved by the State of New Mexico; and,

WHEREAS, the Curry County annual budget is broken down for each department and there are numerous separate line item funds identified for each separate department or program in Curry County; and,

WHEREAS, Elected Officials/Department Heads cannot expend funds or incur expenses until justification and their written request has been submitted and approved by the County Manager. At no time can Elected Officials/Department Head overspend a line item or incur expenses without the line item request being approved by the County Manager in writing; and,

WHEREAS, state law and Curry County regulations authorize and allow the transfer of funds within a budget fund, without County Commission approval.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Curry County, that from this date forward, the Curry County Manager shall have the authority to approve line item transfers within individual budget funds, with the exception of the administration budget fund, if there are sufficient funds available.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that with regard to those line item transfers in the administration line item budget, the County Manager can elect to present those to the full Commission for their approval or have an individual Commissioner review and sign off on the same.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution does not authorize or allow any sums to be transferred out of one budget fund into another budget fund without prior County Commission approval.


