RESOLUTION NO. 2013 – 49**

**A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE CURRY COUNTY 2012 ROAD POLICY**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners of Curry County, which is the duly elected governing body thereof, has, by Resolution 2012-33, adopted the Curry County 2012 Road Policy; and,

**WHEREAS**, the County has periodic Road Committee Meetings; and,

**WHEREAS**, it has been brought up and suggested at the Curry County Road Committee that the current Road Policy be amended to allow the Road Department to blade ditches, back slopes or shoulders when necessary during the period October 1 of any year through April 1 of the following year; and,

**WHEREAS**, it is determined that making said change is in the best interest to Curry County.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners of Curry County that Resolution 2012-33, commonly referred to as the Curry County 2012 Road Policy, be and the same hereby is amended as follows:

- 1) Section VII: Miscellaneous Provisions, Subparagraph 3) C) is deleted in its entirety and a new Section VII: Miscellaneous Provisions, Subparagraph 3) C) is hereby adopted and incorporated into said Road Policy to read as follows:

**C. Blading.** Under normal conditions, Curry County will not blade any ditch, back slopes, or shoulders from October 1 of any year through April 1 of the following year. Exceptions to this general policy may be allowed if the road is under construction or rebuilding is being done on said road.

In addition, with the approval (or supervision) from the Road Superintendent, Road employees may blade the front slopes (or shoulder) of county roads in order to establish water flow down the ditch. In areas where ditches are full of blow sand, again, with the approval (or supervision) of the Road Superintendent, Road employees may clean the ditch in order to reestablish a ditch line capable of keeping rain water off of the roadway. In sandy areas, any blading will only be done with adequate moisture to compact the material on the roadway.

**IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED** that all of the remaining provisions set forth in Resolution 2012-33, the Curry County 2012 Road Policy, are to remain the same and are not to be effected by this Resolution.






