

RESOLUTION NO. 2012-61

ADOPTION OF REQUIRED COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT
POLICIES

WHEREAS, counties or other entities that accept the Community Development Block Grant Funds must adopt certain mandated federal policies; and

WHEREAS, the County of Curry (hereinafter referred to as County) wishes to ensure compliance with federal guidelines by adopting the following required policies:

(A) **Citizen Participation Plan** - encourages citizen participation with particular emphasis on low and moderate income persons; outlines the objectives and plan to implement those objectives

(B) **Residential Anti-Displacement & Relocation Assistance Plan** - certifies that it will replace all occupied and vacant occupiable low/moderate-income dwelling units demolished or converted to a use other than as a low/moderate-income housing as a direct result of activities assisted with Housing and Community Development Funds.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE COUNTY OF CURRY, NEW MEXICO that the County adopts the above-referenced Plans A and B which are attached hereto, for purposes of all community development block grant funds and acknowledges that said plans will have to be re-adopted annually.
