

RESOLUTION 2011- 49
REQUESTING ASSISTANCE FROM THE
NEW MEXICO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

THIS MATTER, having come before the Board of County Commissioners of Curry County, at its regular Commission meeting on the 11th day of October, 2011.

WHEREAS, the Commissioners have been contacted by numerous citizens in Curry County regarding concerns with the intersection of State Road 523 and State Road 108, which is situated in Curry County, New Mexico; and,

WHEREAS, the Commission has been provided with information and concerns from numerous County residents regarding the dangerous situation at the intersection of State Road 523 and State Road 108; and,

WHEREAS, the intersection of State Road 523 and State Road 108 is maintained by the New Mexico Department of Transportation and has stop signs approaching the intersection; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Curry County believe that additional or better stop signs, warning signs and other indicators could reduce the danger to the general public presented at this intersection.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CURRY COUNTY on this 11th day of October, 2011, that the New Mexico Department of Transportation be contacted and made aware of Curry County's concern regarding the safety to the motoring public at the intersection of State Road 523 and State Road 108 in Curry County, New Mexico.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners of Curry County request that the New Mexico Department of Transportation perform an inspection and evaluation of the intersection at State Road 523 and State Road 108 for the purpose of determining appropriate ways in which to reduce the danger and improve the safety at said intersection, including but not limited to installation of flashing safety lights and flashing stop signs at said intersection.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this Resolution be sent to the three (3) New Mexico Senators, and three (3) New Mexico Representatives who represent Curry County in the New Mexico Legislature, the Cabinet Secretary for the New Mexico Department of Transportation and to the Honorable Susana Martinez, Governor of the State of New Mexico.
