A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT IN CURRY COUNTY

WHEREAS, the Board of Curry County Commission supports business growth and economic development and is committed to supporting an environment that is conducive to business retention, expansion, and recruitment efforts; and,

WHEREAS, Curry County is a member of the Clovis/Curry County Chamber of Commerce; and,

WHEREAS, three (3) applicants have recognized what Clovis/Curry County has to offer and have submitted applications to the New Mexico Racing Commission for the sixth Racino license to be situated in Curry County; and,


WHEREAS, the economic impact from the development of a Racino in Clovis/Curry County would bring in to this area anywhere between three hundred (300) and one thousand (1,000) new jobs during the racing season; and,

WHEREAS, Clovis/Curry County is centrally located between Lubbock, TX and Amarillo, TX with approximately an hour and a half (1.5) drive to either city; and,

WHEREAS, there are partnerships that can exist between the Curry County Events Center, a 96,000 square feet multi-purpose facility, that can house equestrian events, concerts, shows with the Racino to provide additional opportunities for additional activities and events to add to the quality of life of Curry County residents.
