WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Curry County, in reviewing the Calendar for the year 2018 desires to establish by this Resolution, the holiday schedule for County Employees.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioner of Curry County that the foregoing below listed schedule of holidays is adopted for all Curry County Personnel for the Calendar year 2018.

New Year's Day 2018	will be observed on Monday-	January 1, 2018
Martin Luther King Jr.'s Birthday	will be observed on Monday-	January 15, 2018
Memorial Day	will be observed on Monday-	May 28, 2018
Independence Day	will be observed on Wednesday-	July 4, 2018
Labor Day	will be observed on Monday-	September 3, 2018
Veteran's Day	will be observed on Friday-	November 9, 2018
Thanksgiving Day	will be observed on Thursday-	November 22, 2018
President's Day	will be observed on Friday-	November 23, 2018
Columbus Day	will be observed on Monday-	December 24, 2018
Christmas Day	will be observed on Tuesday-	December 25, 2018


These holidays are for eight (8) hours, a total of eighty (80) hours. If the employee works a flexible schedule of ten (10) or twelve (12) hours, the employee will only receive eight (8) hours on each holiday and will need to adjust schedule with Department Head or take annual leave or compensatory time.

PASSED, ADOPTED, AND APPROVED this 3rd day of October, 2017 by the Board of County Commissioners.


