
#### AMENDING THE DEDICATION OF A COUNTY LOCAL OPTION GROSS RECEIPTS TAX



**ORDINANCE NUMBER 2020-04**

**AMENDING THE DEDICATION OF A COUNTY LOCAL OPTION  
GROSS RECEIPTS TAX**

**WHEREAS**, Curry County, by Ordinance 90-2, effective January 1, 1991, adopted and approved the imposition of a County Environmental Service Gross Receipt Tax on any person engaging in business in the County area outside of the boundaries of any incorporated municipality; and,

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to changes adopted by the New Mexico Legislature in 2019 and 2020, Curry County has the legal authorization to amend, modify or change the dedication for which the above referenced Environmental Gross Receipt Tax that was adopted; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners of Curry County has determined that the tax obtained from the above referenced Curry County Environmental Gross Receipt Tax would be better used if the dedication of said tax, in Section 4 was changed to be unrestricted.


**NOW BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF** Curry County that Section 4 of Ordinance 90-2, effective January 1, 1991 and imposing one-eighths of one percent (.125%) is amended to read:

**"SECTION 4: Dedication. Revenue from the Environmental Services Gross Receipts Tax will be unrestricted:"**

The effective date of this amendment shall be January 1, 2021 after the expiration of at least three months from the date this ordinance is delivered or mailed to the Taxation and Revenue Department.




