

Voting Convenience Centers = NO wrong place to vote!

WHAT IS A VOTING CONVENIENCE CENTER?

A Voting Convenience Center (VCC) is a location serving as a polling place at which any registered voter in Curry County may vote regardless of the precinct in which the voter is assigned.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q. WHAT IS “CONVENIENT” ABOUT VCC’S?

VCC’s are about voter choice. Traditional specific voting required voters to vote only at his or her assigned voting sites. VCC’s provide voters the option of selecting the polling place that is most convenient to their needs and schedule.

Q. WILL VOTING STILL BE DONE ON PAPER BALLOTS?

Yes. However instead of pre-printing thousands of ballots, as has been the past practice, your ballot will be printed “on demand” at the VCC of your choosing.

Q. WHAT CHANGES CAN I EXPECT AT THE POLLING SITE ON ELECTION DAY?

Voting at a VCC will be conducted in nearly the same manner as traditional voting with the exception that paper ballots will be printed on-site for each voter with the ballot on demand system (BOD).

Q. HOW WILL I KNOW WHICH BALLOT I WILL NEED TO VOTE ON?

All VCC locations will be securely connected to the electronic voter registration data base. When a voter arrives to vote at a VCC, his or her identity will be verified and the correct precinct will be provided. This information is then used to print the appropriate ballot for the voter.

Q. DO I NEED TO SHOW IDENTIFICATION WHEN I VOTE?

You do not have to present a photo ID.

Q. WILL I STILL HAVE THE OPTION TO VOTE ABSENTEE OR EARLY?

Yes. Absentee and early voting will be carried out in the same fashion, as in a standard County election.

Q. WILL VOTING AT A VCC INCREASE THE LIKLIHOOD OF BEING ABLE TO VOTE AT MORE THAN ONE LOCATION?

No. When a voter casts a vote at any VCC it is immediately recorded in the database and at all other VCC’s, thus preventing any voter from attempting to vote at more than one location.

Q. WILL SITES BE IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE AMERICAN DISABILITY ACT (ADA) OF 1990?

Yes. All polling locations will meet or exceed ADA accessibility requirements.
