Health Council Coordinator’s Summary of Events and Activities – Annie Hogland on behalf of Susan Alman

Hogland read aloud the Coordinator’s Summary on behalf of Alman: 1) On June 2, 2018 we held the Baby Expo in the Parking Lot of 417 Gidding. Had a great time and gave out a bunch of diapers and baby wipes; 2) On June 8, we attended Our Lady of Guadalupe Fiesta; 3) June 16, we attended the Juneteenth Celebration; 4) On June 26 I attended the JJAC Meeting representing the Health Council; 5) On June 28, I submitted a Proclamation for National UV Safety Month and gave out sunscreen.

Open Issues

CCHC Health Fair/ National Night Out Event Flyer has been created approved by County Manager and ready for distribution. Vendor forms are updated and being distributed. Event will take place August 7th 2018.

Tammy Phillips provided an update on the Care Guide Project that the Health Council will be partnering with Presbyterian on. Sub-Committee met on Tuesday, July 10, 2018. Health and Wellness in Albuquerque is interested in helping fund the project. Some quotes have been retrieved

for the project and it will cost approximately \$5,000- \$6,000. Philips stated that that Subcommittee has chosen a potential name of "Curry County Support Guide," and determined the booklet will be similar to those printed for the Prescription Trail Guide (Stapled, color, table of contents). Group discussed the information offered by United Way's 211 but agreed there is still a need for this guide in the community.

Alman will be teaming up with Rose Ann Martinez to represent the Curry County Health Council and Foster Grandparent Program at the Ethnic Fair, July 21, 2018.

Phillips worked with Rooney and Moon Broadcasting to offer PSA's to three local radio stations for warnings on rattlesnakes and wildlife presence in town.

New Business

Proclamations for September are National Childhood Obesity Month and National Dental Hygiene Month. Proclamation for October is Domestic Violence Awareness Month. Group discussed Back to School focus for the month of August, including eye exams and immunizations.

School Supply and Back Pack distributions throughout the community, in addition to the Health Fair, were discussed, including: Eagles, American Legion, Razor Barber Shop, and Faith Christian Family Church.

Tanya Henderson of Curry County OSAP said the program will be having 2 (two) townhall meetings, one on underage drinking and one on prescription drug abuse.
