Approval of Minutes – Tanya Henderson moved to approve meeting minutes of May 16, 2019 second by Oriana Riley.

Health Council Coordinator's summary of completed events – Susan Alman

Alman provided an update to the members for recently completed events. The Blood Drive held May 24, 2019, had lower than normal donors, but Alman stated that is to be expected this time of year. The June 1, 2019 Community Resources Event was held at the Curry County Administrative Complex at 417 Gidding. Vendor turnout was high, with only one no-show, who has been contacted. Participation from the community could be considered low, but members believe this was a step in the right direction.

Members discussed location suggestions for next year's event, including the Curry County Event Center Pavillion, Youth Recreation Building, Roy Walker Center, Clovis Carver Public Library, and the Master's Center. Alman read aloud a Proclamation for Men's Health Month (June) at the June 4, 2019 regular county commission meeting. Alman also stated that following the proclamation, Francisco Mimica of the NM Department of Health provided the Commission with the presentation of which he gave at the May Health Council meeting.

Health Council Coordinator's summary of upcoming events – Susan Alman

Copies of the "Activities and Events for 2019-2020" were distributed. Alman asked members for feedback and additions. Tanya Henderson of Curry County OSAP asked that the DEA Drug Take Back events dates be added. At a County Commission Meeting in July, Alman will present a Proclamation for UV Protection. Alman and Martinez announced Juneteenth celebration event to be held at Potter Park on Saturday, June 15, 2019 from 10:00am – 4:00pm.

Financial Report – Suzanne Zamora, acting Treasurer, provided financial report: Current balance (as of June 7, 2019) of the Wellness Council fund is \$8,719.58. Zamora noted that Curry County is awaiting an invitation to apply for NM Department of Health Funds for the upcoming fiscal year, anticipating a potential award amount of \$6,000 - \$7,000.

Open Issues

The annual Ethnic Fair will be held July 27, 2019. Curry County Health Council will be signing-up as a vendor, and Alman asked for volunteer(s) to man the booth, as she will be unable to attend. If no member volunteers, the Health Council Booth will partner with Curry County FGP/RSVP Programs to be manned by the respective program's volunteers. Alman announced members of the National Night Out 2019 (Back to School Health Fair) subcommittee, and asked that anyone who was not called that would like to participate to come forward. Subcommittee will hold their first meeting Tuesday, July 25, 2019 from 3:00pm – 4:00pm.

New Business

Members discussed upcoming vote for new Executive Committee members (Chairman, Co-Chairman, Treasurer) in July.

Alman reminded members to complete and submit forms from Welcome Packets in preparation for submitting CCHC Membership Roster to the Curry County Commission.

Other Health Council Members' Status Reports

Teresa Broeker (Clovis Health Office) provided a brief update and noted a prevalence of measles in US. She added that one case was confirmed in Dona Ana County, potentially a false positive, but shared the importance of MMR vaccines.

Kaylee Vineyard (MECA Therapies) shared information on questionnaire/ screening event that will be taking place July 19, 2019 at CCC. She added the Cannon AFB will be holding their annual back to school fair event on August 2nd, and would forward vendor forms to members.

Desa Silbaugh (Wheatfields) invited everyone to attend upcoming "Summer Movies Under the Stars" events at Wheatfields, the last Wednesday of each month this summer.

Cathy Wehlage (Compassus Hospice) distributed brochures and business cards.

Renita Borders (Healthy Haven Counseling) gave an overview of services, noting online and video services.

Melissa Mileg shared information on Summer Wellness Campaign.

Destry Hernenadez and Norma Garcia (Mental Health Resources) introduced themselves and gave an overview of services. Distributed brochures and business cards.

Laura Leeder- Martinez (United Way) distributed flyers for upcoming events/ campaigns.

Tabitha Durnak (Pecos Valley Production) introduced herself and gave an overview of services.
