IV. Approval of minutes:

1st – Carissa Caroland and **2nd – Joseph Williams** moved to approve the minutes of May 22nd, 2019.

V. OSAP Program Manager's summary of events:

1) Tanya Henderson went on a minor compliance checks ride-along with NMSP SIU agents on 5/25/2019. They were unable to do minor compliance checks in Curry County due to storm, which delayed them by 2 hours. There was an approximate total of 5 gas stations, 1 grocery store, and 2 restaurants operations in Portales, NM. There was 1 violation at Juanito's Mexican restaurant, and they were given a citation.

2) Henderson finished and completed the end of year reporting. It was due on 7/15/2019, Curry County's report was submitted on 7/12/2019.

3) The Curry County Health Council hosted a back to school health fair and **Henderson** signed up as a vendor. The event occurred on 8/6/2019 and did community outreach. La Casa Family Health Center also hosted a back to school event on 8/9/2019, and OSAP was set up as a vendor as well.

VI. Open Issues:

1) Drug Free Communities Grant:

Curry County decided to not pursue the DFC grant. Curry County did not meet all the grant requirements including being able to provide a 100% funding match.

Rey had mentioned that only was it 100% during the first year, but it would steadily increase every year after to 125% then to 150% funding match.

2) OSAP's Recipient's Meeting:

Henderson was asked to be a provider highlight for the Recipient's meeting in Albuquerque, New Mexico. The strategy that Curry County was asked to speak about was strategy A1d, the ATOD Policy in schools. The State was impressed with the results and relationships Curry County has with Clovis Municipal Schools.

Henderson met with Joe Strickland to discuss the beginning process prior OSAP coming into the support the ATOD policy change. Strickland provided great information and great advice for other communities throughout New Mexico.

VII. New Business:

1) FOA Update:

Henderson and **Rey** both stated that we have not heard anything back about the FOA we submitted back in March 2019.

2) ASFS/NMCS Survey Results:

Morrison introduced herself as Curry County's local evaluator and traveled from Albuquerque, New Mexico. **Morrison** created a PowerPoint presentation and a Snapshot of the New Mexico Community Surveys and Annual Strategies for Success Surveys. **Morrison** noted that Clovis High Schools were not able to compare results from previous years. The data could not be presented well since there are no indications of changes over time from same data collection methods. In FY18, there were 2 middle schools & no high schools participation, and in FY17 CHS did participate, however, there was inconsistency to compare changes over time. **Morrison** also noted that the high school results were 9th grade dominant. **Morrison** presented all the data together, but will be separating results by schools later on. Each coalition member were given a data snapshot.


3) SAMHSA Communities Talk Stipend:
