

**RESOLUTION 2020-19**

**A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 2017-12,  
ADOPTING THE CURRY COUNTY ROAD POLICY**

**WHEREAS**, by Resolution adopted on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of February, 2017, the Board of County Commissioners of Curry County adopted Resolution No. 2017-12, which adopted the new Curry County Road Policy; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Curry County Road Committee has recommended to the Board of County Commissioners that the policy and procedure pertaining to road closures by the Road Superintendent should be amended to grant the Road Superintendent the right to close any County road(s) when, in the Superintendent's opinion, the road presents a danger to the public; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners of Curry County would like to amend Curry County Road Policy Resolution No. 2017-12.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, Section IV, Temporary Road Closures** be and the same hereby is deleted in its entirety from the Road Policy.


**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that a new **Section IV Temporary Road Closures** shall be added to the Road Policy and shall read as follows:

- The Road Superintendent, in his/her discretion can close or authorize the temporary closure of a County Road for any period up to but not to exceed thirty (30) consecutive days. The Road Superintendent upon closing a road, shall provide information pertaining to the reason for the closure to the Board of County Commissioners at their next regularly scheduled Commission meeting and thereafter, at each meeting until said Road is opened. Any road closure for more than thirty (30) days in length must be approved by the Board of County Commissioners in a public meeting. The Road Superintendent shall provide the Board of County Commissioners with an update on any and all roads closed for more than thirty (30) days at least quarterly.

**IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED** that all of the remaining terms and conditions as set forth in Resolution No. 2017-12, not specifically altered or amended herein, shall remain in full force and effect.






